
## Distribution

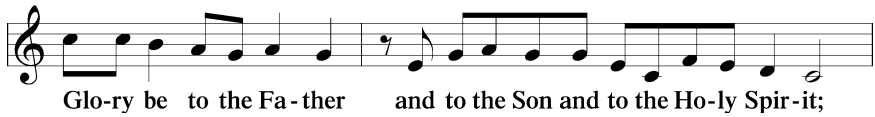

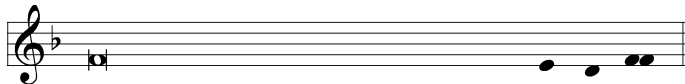
